

What do Impact Missions look like?

- ◆ Impact Missions bring churches together across Europe for an intensive period of missional endeavor.
- ◆ Impact Missions usually take place over a four or five day period (e.g. Thursday to Monday, or Saturday to Thursday).
- ◆ The host church determines what the outreach time will consist of. This will be highly relational and aligned with their context and location.
- ◆ Several key events might take place over the period of time. Some may target Youth, Men, Women, The business community, Sports, Music/Arts etc.
- ◆ The preparation of the Impact Mission will match gifting and life experience with expectations/plans of the host.
- ◆ IC will assist with brainstorming, training and the strategy for both the sending and host churches.

International Commission is an independent organization that promotes and facilitates global evangelism projects.

It was born out of a vision for church-to-church evangelism projects that have a positive and long-term impact on both those who receive and those who volunteer and go.

The Western European leadership for IC has been engaged in team evangelism projects in Western Europe for more than 30 years.

The EuroLeadership Team is comprised of leaders from each nation. The Team takes ownership of the strategies proposed within Western Europe.

Ultimately, the leadership from each country determines the particular strategy to follow as a decision is made to host a project.
