Tuesday, July 20

- Fly from USA on overnight flight to Dublin, Ireland

Wednesday, July 21

- Arrival in Dublin
- Check into hotel

- Orientation meeting in the afternoon

Friday, July 23

- Travel to your assigned location of service in County Donegal
- Meet your hosts and have a time of planning and strategy development
