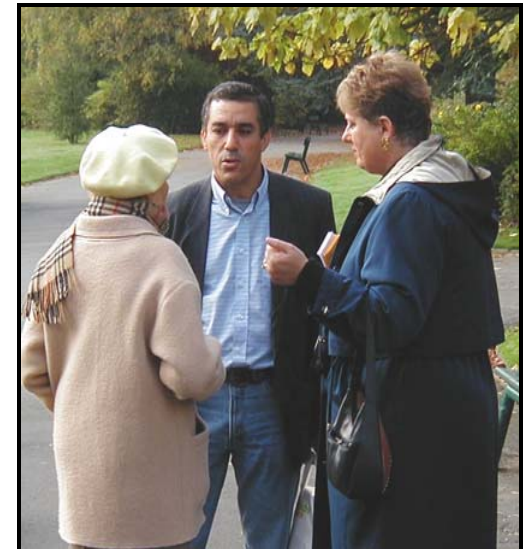

Magerarfelt Baptist Church has a passion to begin new evangelical work in County Donegal with a population of 130,000 in the North-West region of Ireland. The Evangelical presence is very small and little has been done in outreach in recent years even though it once was a famous base for Celtic Christianity in the sixth century.

The invitation comes from Magerarfelt Baptist Church to join them for a week of making contacts, building friendships in an area that has had little contact with the Gospel. Methods used include visiting people in their homes, using the Jesus video and/or working with youth. The team from FBC, Carrollton will be one of several teams that will serve from April through July. The goal is to plant a church in County Donegal.

This project is in cooperation with the Magerarfelt Baptist Church which is in Strabane, County Tyrone, Northern Ireland and the European Christian Mission who has a church planter working in Donegal, Ireland. The church planter's name is Alan Armstrong and the pastor of the Magerarfelt Baptist Church is Clive Johnston.

The call is to come and work in the people fields of Ireland and to share your faith with the intent of beginning a new church.
