Wednesday, May 20

- Fly from USA on overnight flight to Dublin, Ireland

Thursday, May 21

- Arrival in Dublin
- Check into hotel
- Remainder of day for rest or individual exploring

Friday, May 22

- Breakfast at hotel
- Tour of the City
- Orientation meeting in the afternoon

Saturday, May 23

- Travel to your assigned location of service, Belfast
- Meet your hosts and perhaps some a planning meeting at the church

Sunday, May 24— Saturday, May 30

- Visiting, survey work, showing Jesus film, building relationships and sharing the Gospel
- Meetings and conversations in diverse locations from Parliament, to union halls, to bars and pubs

- Return to Dublin and check into hotel.

Based on December 2008 Fares:

Costs are based on fares & fuel charges according to prices in December 2008. Cost may have to be adjusted increases not under IC control. After April 1, 2009 these costs no longer apply and new costs will have to be computed on an individual basis.
